

ALE OUTSTANDING PROGRAM AWARD APPLICATION

This award is designed to recognize outstanding leadership programs developed or implemented by ALE members. Past recipients of the award have included (but are not limited to) leadership majors, minors, certificate programs, leadership workshops/programs, youth development programs, and adult leadership development programs.

Eligibility: Nominees must meet the following eligibility criteria.

- 1) Program developer(s) must be ALE members in good standing
- 2) Applicants may not have already received this award.
- 3) The program must have data that substantiates impact on individuals, organizations, institutions, and/or communities.

Application process

Submit a description of the program outlining the following information no longer than 3 double-spaced pages with 12 point font and 1 inch margins

- 1) Applicant(s) with contact information (name, address, email address, phone)
- 2) Name of program
- 3) Program description
- 4) Audience/participants: who were the participants; why was this program important/helpful to them?
- 5) Impact of the program; what were the impacts on individuals, organizations, and/ or communities?
- 6) Sustained program excellence: durability of the program

Selection

The recipient(s) of this award will be selected by the ALE Awards and Recognition Committee. Applications will be judged by the following criteria:

- Program design 25 points
- Significance of results 25 points
- Program impacts 25 points
- Sustainability of program 25 points
- Total 100 points
